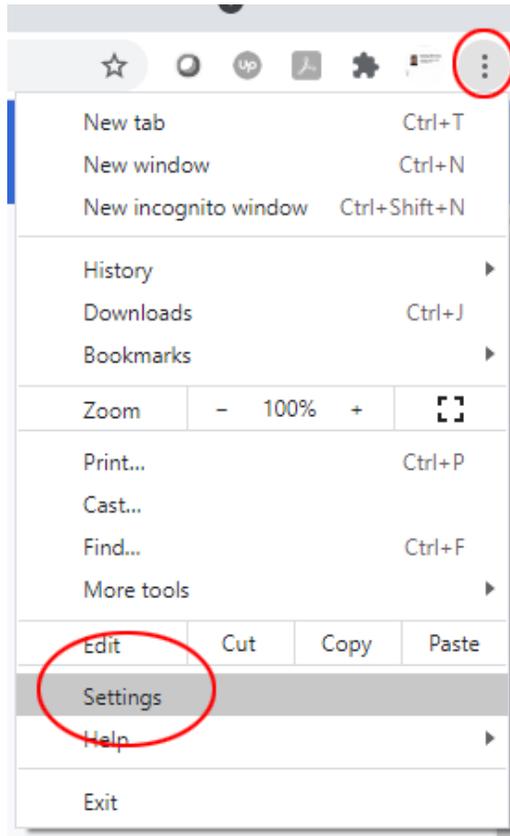
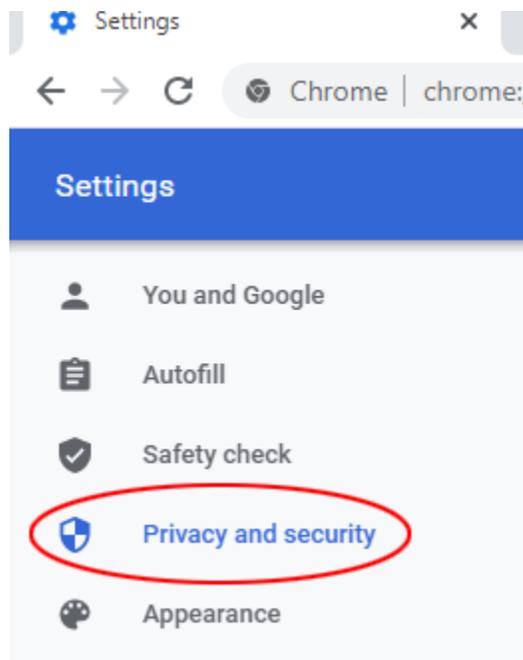


Change the Default PDF Viewer in Chrome

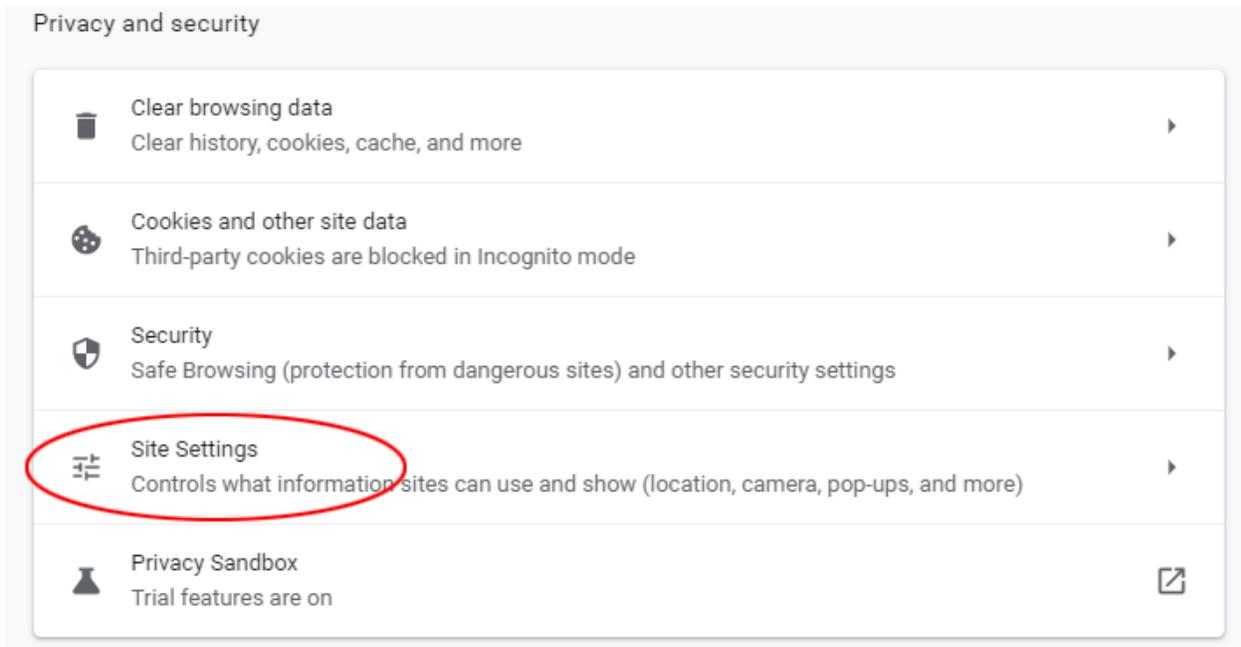
Step 1: Open "Settings" in Chrome



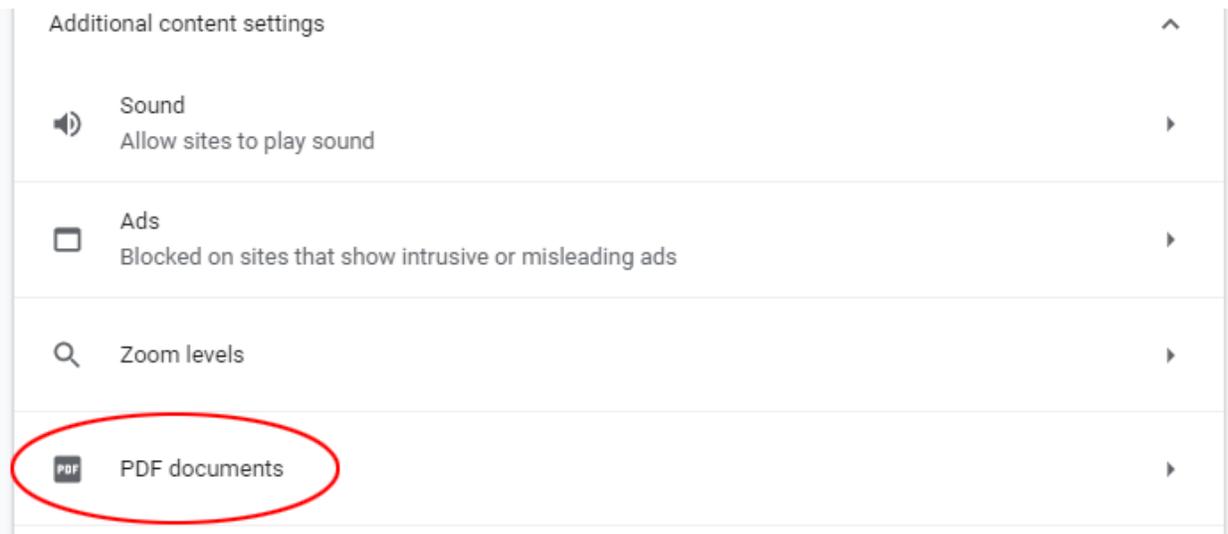
Step 2: Select "Privacy and security"



Step 3: Select "Site Setting"

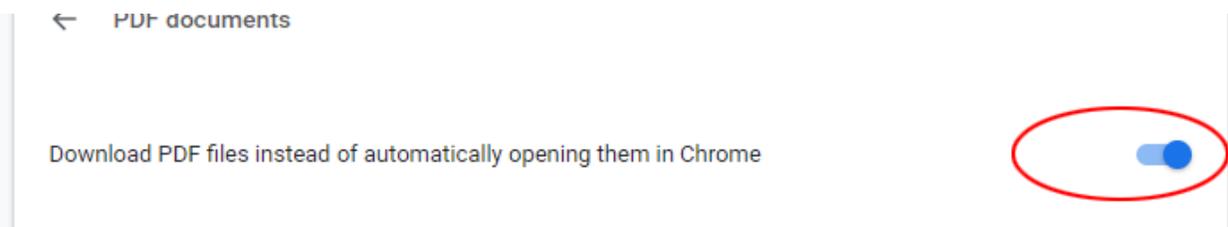


Step 5: Select "Download PDF files instead" toggle button.



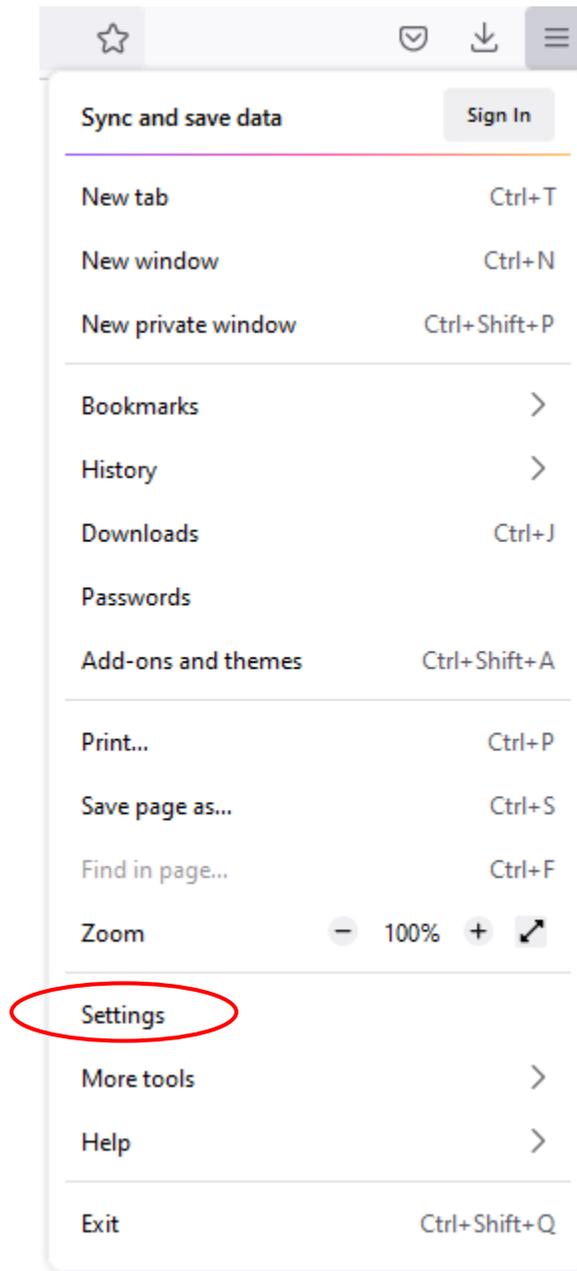
Step 4: Select "PDF documents" under "Additional content settings".

Note: you may need to scroll down and click the up/down arrow next to "Additional content settings" to see "PDF documents".

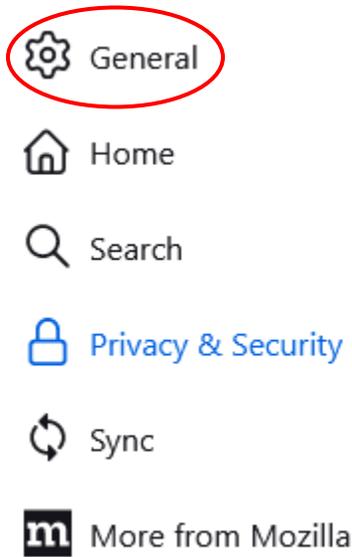


Change the Default PDF Viewer in Firefox

Step 1: Open "Settings" in Firefox



Step 2: Select "General"



Step 4: Select the down arrow beside "Portable Document Format (PDF)" under "Applications".

Step 5: Select "Always Ask" to be prompted with an option to open the PDF file or select "Use Windows default application"/"Use macOS default application" to open automatically with Adobe Acrobat.

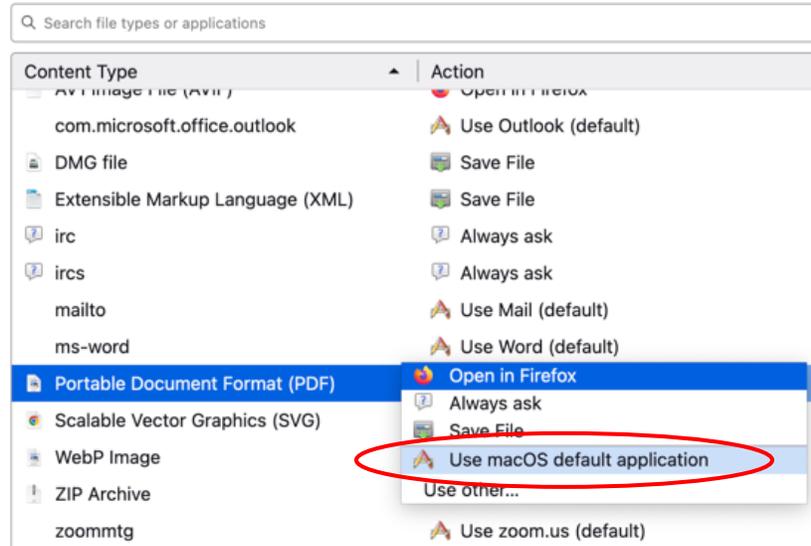
